Through Jim, the Foundation contacted Mike Curb of Curb Records in an attempt to bring an "up and coming" country star to the event to help raise awareness and funds.

In 1999, the Easterbrook Family was extremely pleased to be introduced to Mr. Steve Holy, a country singer on the Curb label ("Good Morning Beautiful", "The Hunger", etc.). Steve played at the "thank you" party given the night before at the Easterbrook's home, and also played golf the next day.

During the evening, Steve heard Ashley's story. Late that night, Steve called back to the house and asked for a copy of her diary article expressing her fear of being killed by a drunk driver and the message she left her family. It was faxed over to the hotel after midnight. As a result, Steve wrote the song which you can hear part of here. The Foundation is currently awaiting permission to put the entire song on this website.
