Who We Are

The Teen Advisory Consultants of the **Baldwin Public Library** are teaming up this summer with the **Foundation for Ashley’s Dream** to reduce the threat of drunk drivers on our streets.

About the Foundation

The Foundation for Ashley’s Dream (www.ashleysdream.org) honors the memories of Ashley Easterbrook, Michael Jamieson, Andy Stindt and Jeremy St Cyr. All four students from Troy High Schools were innocent victims, killed by drunk drivers in the spring of 1997. Ashley’s Dream has awarded tens of thousands of dollars every year in college scholarships. Winning students are selected on the basis of several factors, including activism in the cause against drunk driving and a personal account of how drinking and driving has touched their lives.

Our Objective

We want to raise \$1,000 for Foundation for Ashley’s Dream.

To accomplish our goal, we created the “Buck a Book” reading challenge. Teens who participate in the program will secure sponsors to donate \$1 for every book they read.

Rules

- Program is open to teens in grades 6-12.
- Registration begins Monday, June 20, 2005. The program will end on Friday, August 12, 2005 at 12 Noon.
- **It’s easy!** For every book you read this summer, sponsors will donate \$1.00.
- Participants may solicit more than one sponsor for each book read.
- Don’t forget to sign the waiver at the bottom of this form if you are under 18 years of age.

- The deadline for turning money in is Friday, August 12. You may turn the money in sooner.
